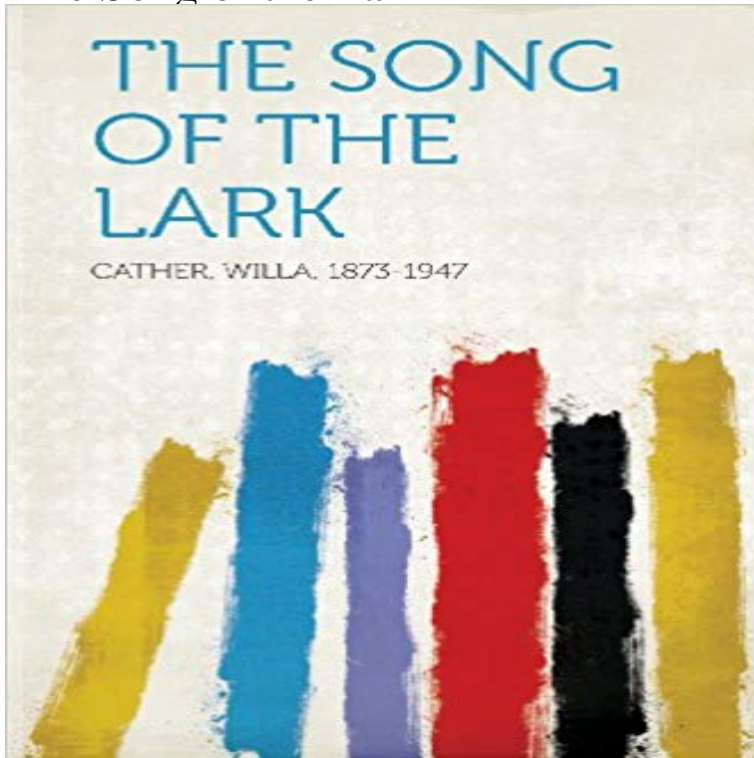


The Song of the Lark
