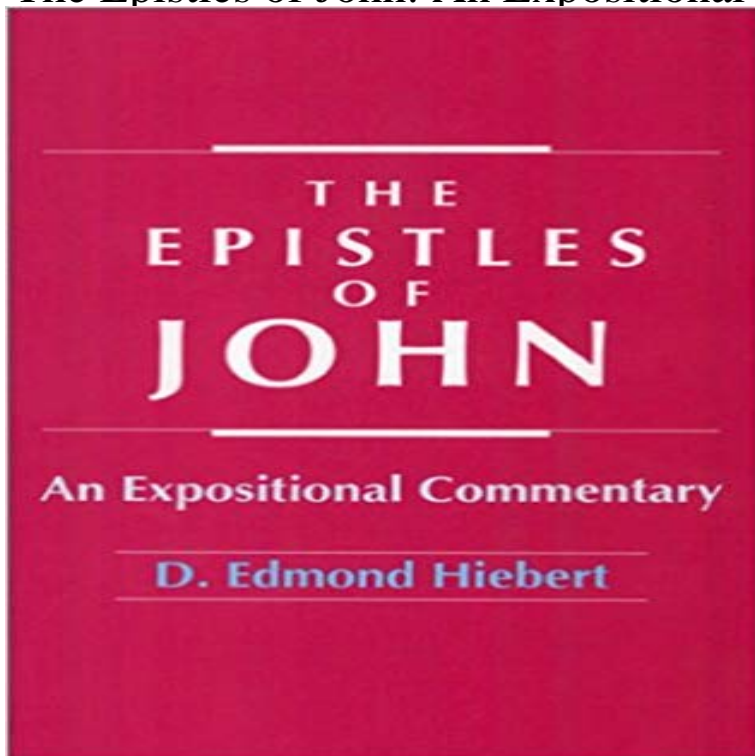


# The Epistles of John: An Expositional Commentary
