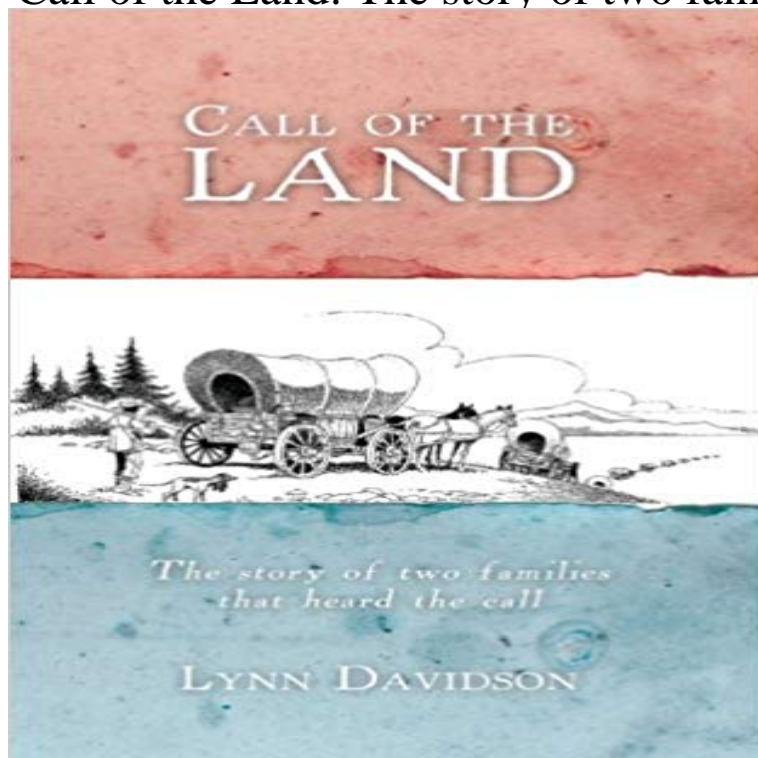


Call of the Land: The story of two families that heard the call
