
Peace With China?: U.S. Decisions for Asia



Suddenly, after twenty-five years of official hostility, Americans are confronted with an extraordinary reversal of their governments attitude toward China. How and why was the course of Americas relationship to Asia changed? What are the prospects for detente with the Peoples Republic of China? How might the new course affect Americas economy and her relations with other nations, especially Japan and the USSR? These questions form the basis of a wide-ranging inquiry held recently at the Institute for Policy Studies in Washington and recorded in Peace with China? Government officials candidly discuss emerging foreign policies. Former members of the Kennedy and Johnson administrations analyze the political and military realities as they saw them. Finally, critics of Americas actions Asiaincluding spokemen for New Left and revisionist positionscontribute viewpoints and alternatives. The result is a unique scrutiny of the complex processes by which the White House, State Department, and Pentagon devise strategies, as well as a lively but scholarly debate on American options in Asia.
