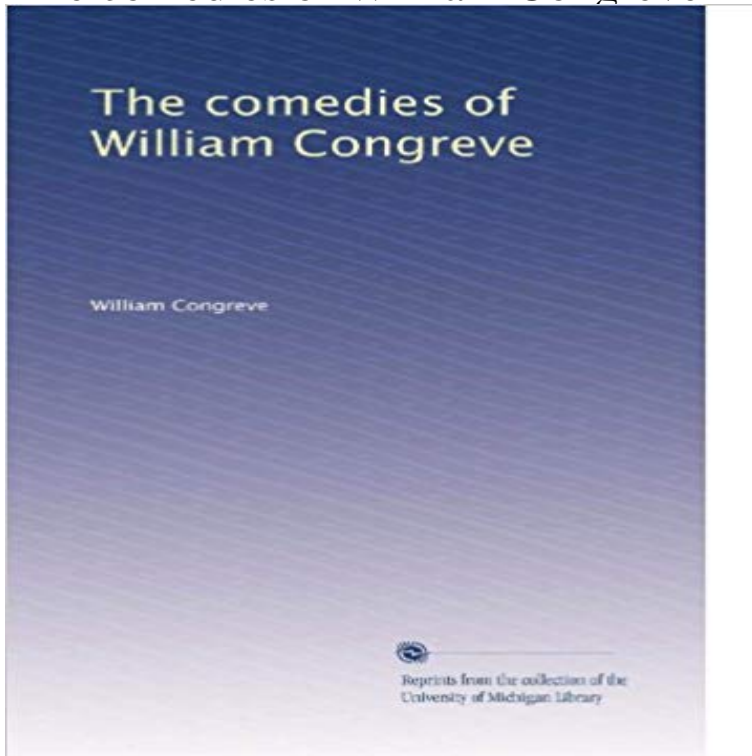


The comedies of William Congreve
